# The Victorian Golf Association 2008 Junior Program



## JANUARY

### **Victorian Junior Summer Competition**

Co-run with the Stuart Appleby Foundation and Women's Golf Victoria, this event is played over 18 holes (U14, U16 and U18 boys and U18 girls) 9 holes (shortened course) (U15 boys and girls). The Championship consists of a number of qualifying venues in Melbourne and country Victoria throughout the summer school holiday period culminating in a final held in Melbourne. In each age division, there are Gross and Nett winners. Entry forms available from October. Handicaps not required.

### **Victorian Junior Masters**

Played at Waverley Golf Club over 72 holes. Maximum field of 180 reduced to 80 plus ties following 36 holes. Boys under 18 years of age with handicaps not exceeding 20 are eligible to enter. Limited number of girls by invitation. Trophies for gross and nett winners over 72 holes together with U16 and U14 age groups trophies. Entry forms available October.

## FEBRUARY/MARCH

### **Victorian School Teams Championship**

This Championship consists of qualifying events at 6 venues (4 city, 2 country) with teams of three from the same school competing to qualify for the final at Metropolitan Golf Club. Winning Victorian team to compete in the National Championship in March. Two divisions for boys and girls under 18 years. Entry forms available October. Handicaps not required.

## JANUARY, MARCH, JUNE & OCTOBER

### **Victorian Under 12's Junior Golf**

Co-run with the Stuart Appleby Foundation, this event is open to boys & girls under 12 as at date of event and is played over 18 holes stroke play at Waverley Pitch & Putt Golf Course. Trophies in multiple age groups for gross & nett. Played in every school holiday period, entry forms available at [www.stuartappleby.com.au](http://www.stuartappleby.com.au) approximately 6 weeks before each event.

## APRIL

### **Australian Boys' Amateur Championship & Australia Boys' Interstate Series**

Played in a different state each year. Team of six boys under 18 selected to represent Victoria. Individuals may enter as well. Trophies for Interstate Teams Matches, Interstate Teams Stroke Play Event and Wilson Junior Championship of Australia.

## JUNE

### **Victorian Junior Stableford Championship**

Individual Stableford Competition played at Koorinal Golf Club over 18 holes. Trophies for overall winners, U18, U16 and U14 winners for both boys and girls.

## JULY

### **Junior Championship of Victoria**

72 hole Championship played at Yarra Yarra and Northern Golf Clubs over two days. Includes Under 18, Under 16 and Under 14 Championship titles. Entry forms available April.

## AUGUST

### **Victorian Primary Schools Championship**

Open to students enrolled in schools affiliated with VPSSA. Qualifying rounds at 55 courses around Victoria during August with final conducted in September. Entry forms available June

## SEPTEMBER/OCTOBER

### **Boys' Championship of Victoria**

Boys aged 18 with Australian handicaps. 36 holes stroke play to qualify. 16 players for elimination match play. 36 hole final. Entry forms available July.

## NOVEMBER & DECEMBER

### **Junior Pennant Competition**

Open to boys and girls under 18 as at mid December. Home and away metropolitan pennant competition conducted in multiple divisions. Players having previously played in excess of three games of VGA or WGV pennant are ineligible to compete. No handicap limit.

### **Country Regions Junior Competition**

16 District Golf Associations represented by teams of boys under 18.

## ANNUALLY

### **Geoff Ogivly Trophy**

Open to the boys aged under 18 on 1st January with a handicap limit of 10 or less. A minimum of 15 stroke play rounds must be played throughout the year in designated events to be eligible. Also consists of an Under 16 & Under 14 section. Entry forms available October.

### **Junior State Squad**

Eligible players are male junior golfers under 18 years of age as at April 2009 (exact dates depend on Interstate Series) who have an Australian Handicap not exceeding 6 strokes. The squad will consist of 24 junior golfers who will participate in the Victorian Junior State Squad program from July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008 and ultimately culminate in the selection of the team of 6 boys chosen to represent Victoria in the Australian Boys' Interstate Series in 2009. Entries available from April.

### **Under 16 & 14 Development Squads**

Open to boys aged under 16 & 14 as at the 1<sup>st</sup> January. Program includes an intensive 5 day training camp at Mirboo North, ongoing tuition through the year with State Coaches, session on various sports science and golf related topics and an individual coaching subsidy. Entries available from April.

### **Golf in Schools**

Schools based program of elementary tuition by professional coaches. Interested schools and students should contact the VGA.

### **School Access Program**

Primary school based program where VGA sports development officer provides access to basic golf tuition and Go-Go-Golf. Enquiries to the VGA.

# 2008 PROGRAM OF EVENTS

## - OVERVIEW -



### **"BIG GOLF DAYS OUT"**

**Levels 1-2**

Designed for children aged 5-12 years, each of the "Big Golf Days Out" is specific to young children yet to start or just getting started in learning to play the game of golf. Children take part in fun games that develop skills appropriate in learning the basics of golf technique, safety and enjoyment of the game. Each child receives a terrific registration pack. All equipment is provided by SAJG, with introductory children's coaching by SAJG staff, PGA and ALPG members. Duration is typically 3 hours, held at venues around the state in school holiday periods.

### **"UNDER 16 JUNIOR CLASSICS"**

**Levels 2-4**

The Under 16 Junior Classics are co-branded events, supported by the Victorian golf bodies and fully administered by SAJG. Played over 18 holes at the Australian Pitch'n'Putt course in Mulgrave, these events are ideal for junior golfers learning to play the game of golf, who can competently play 9 holes on a standard golf course. They are also great fun for seasoned junior golfers as the course provides a great challenge for all abilities. The events are played in age divisions for both girls and boys and are scheduled on the last Friday of each school holiday period.

### **"TEAM APPLES"**

**Levels 2-4**

"Team Apples" is a 9 hole team-based event for girls and boys, run in Terms 1 and 4, over a five week period. It is designed to provide young golfers with a competition experience in a fun format. The competition includes a section for children up to the age of 16 with golf handicaps. Minimal golf experience is required, but players must be able to play 9 holes. There is a team focus at all times and a team ladder is produced at the end of each week. After the 4 qualifying weeks, the leading teams from each venue gather to compete in the Team Apples Final. Team Apples is played in a 2 ball Ambrose format with modified rules in the non-handicap section and individual Stableford in the handicap section. It is a Sunday afternoon competition, with heaps of great prizes and loads of fun!

### **"WINTER SERIES"**

**Levels 2-4**

Winter Series events are staged on the final Sunday of each month in April, May, June, July and August similar to Team Apples and at a range of venues. Play each month or simply enter one or two - it's totally up to you! Open to boys and girls aged 8-16 years, each event is played over 9 holes. The non-handicap section is played in a 2 ball Ambrose format with modified rules and individual Stableford in the handicap section. It is a Sunday afternoon competition, with heaps of great prizes and loads of fun!

### **"SAJG JUNIOR OPEN DAYS"**

**Levels 1-6**

Each year SAJG conducts Junior Open Days. These gala days are played at venues special to SAJG and comprise 3 separate sections: *"Big Golf Day Out"...9 hole Competition...18 hole Competition.* Designed to provide "something for everyone" these days have proven to be extremely popular for all players.

### **"JUNIOR SUMMER SERIES"**

**Levels 3-5**

The Junior Summer Series are co-branded events, supported by the Victorian golf bodies and fully administered by the VGA. Played over 9 and 18 holes at a number of venues across Victoria and metropolitan Melbourne, the Junior Summer Series provides opportunity to compete at a regional level and qualify for the Summer Series Final.

### **"REGIONAL SERIES CUP"**

**Levels 3-6**

New in 2008, the Regional Series is designed to provide gross and nett competition opportunities in 18 hole events across Victoria. The Series is played along the lines of the Fedex Cup, with points allocated to players dependent upon their placing in the event across 3 handicap divisions. 18 events are scheduled across Victoria, with the total of the 4 best points scores (72 holes) contributing to the overall player standing for the year. Full details of the points allocation and terms and conditions are listed on the SAJG website. Great prizes are allocated to each event, with the overall winners claiming the REGIONAL SERIES CUP.

### **"CLUB TEAMS CHAMPIONSHIP"**

**Levels 3-6**

SAJG's Club Teams Championship is open to every golf club in Victoria to enter! Teams of 4 boys and/or girls represent their club at their Regional Qualifying event (played regionally throughout Victoria), and have the opportunity to progress to the annual Championship Final, played at Kingston Heath Golf Club! Past winners include Spring Valley GC, Bendigo GC and Latrobe GC.

## "SAJG SIGNATURE TOURNAMENT"

Levels 4-6

SAJG's premier event! Played annually in December at a great golf venue this event continues to grow in prestige and attract some of the best juniors from around the state. The Signature T'ment also incorporates the Victorian Junior Long Drive Championship.

## "SAJG JUNIOR CAMP"

Levels 4-6

The SAJG Junior Camp is designed to provide a premier golf learning experience in a great golf environment. This three day experience is designed to assist young players who don't have ready access to coaching and are seeking to make the steps to game improvement.

## "MONTHLY MEDAL"

Levels 4-6

Compete state-wide without leaving your home club!! Simply send in your two best competition scores for the month and you could be the SAJG Monthly Medalist! All Monthly Medalists then compete for the Stuart Appleby Medal.

## "JUNIOR ACE"

Score a hole in one to win! If you achieve a golfing "ace" SAJG would like to help you celebrate your great shot. Win a box of golf balls, have your name listed on the SAJG website and receive a Junior Ace certificate signed by Stuart.

## "TEAM GOLF FOR SCHOOLS"

The Team Golf for schools program is designed to offer children the opportunity of learning and competing in Australia's largest participant sport. By offering this golf program to all Victorian Secondary Schools (years 7-9), SAJG is making golf more accessible to the schools. It also adds to the experiences of children already exposed to golf through their Primary School and the VPSSA championship. The TEAM GOLF program takes place in the second half of the year, commencing with school visits and clinics. Schools then nominate their teams to compete in the 9 hole Ambrose event in their region. Leading teams from each of the regional finals then move on to compete in the State Final.
